Mission Apprentices – Diocese of Birmingham	A Diocesan project to train Mission Apprentices combining structured training and mission experience in deprived parishes.	£100,000
'Sorted' – Diocese of Bradford	Development of an existing successful youth evangelism project working with multi-cultural communities in deprived areas in the Diocese of Bradford.	£100,000
'Jesus Shaped People' – Diocese of Bradford	Replication of a vision of mission which has delivered steady and sustained growth in a very deprived estate, into five parishes with similar social profiles in the Diocese of Bradford.	£100,000
'Ignite' – Diocese of Canterbury	The 'Ignite' Project at St Paul's Cliftonville is employing a missionary to replicate an established model of community ministry from a deprived neighbourhood into another area.	£100,000
OpShops – Diocese of Carlisle	Fulfilling the discipleship potential of a model of outreach and mission, based on a network of shops, which is potentially both highly replicable and financially sustainable, originated in the Diocese of Carlisle.	£97,000
'The Bridge' School of Mission and Church Planting – Diocese of Chester	Training mission pioneers in a Fresh Expression which has grown strongly in a very deprived estate setting within the Diocese of Chester.	£100,000
'Open Door' – St Paul with St Luke, Tranmere – Diocese of Chester	Development and replication of a weekday fellowship for unchurched people which has effectively formed a Fresh Expression for people with high levels of need in very deprived parishes within the Diocese of Chester.	£95,320
Mission Leadership – Diocese of Coventry	Training and mentoring of young mission leaders, based in deprived parishes showing good levels of growth.	£100,000
'Re-opening the North-East' - St Thomas, Stockton – Diocese of Durham	Mission training project in a parish which has grown strongly in an extremely deprived area of the Diocese of Durham.	£100,000

Sensing Salvation – St Peter, Wisbech – Diocese of Ely	Expansion of an arts-based evangelisation project, including an internship programme, reaching out to deprived and unchurched children and families in a rural town with several highly deprived communities within the Diocese of Ely.	£100,000
St Paul, Stonehouse – Diocese of Exeter	Dissemination of children and youth work which has led to growth in a deprived parish, by working with other parishes and providing mentoring in the Diocese of Exeter.	£99,770
Eyres Monsell and New Parks Parish Development Project – Diocese of Leicester	Augmenting existing growth, using mission workers to help develop the ministry in two Anglo-Catholic parishes with very high levels of multiple deprivation in the Diocese of Leicester.	£100,000
Liverpool Cathedral Mission Project – Diocese of Liverpool	Using the Cathedral as a resource to support the replication of a Cathedral-based Fresh Expressions into deprived parishes.	£100,000
St Andrew, Clubmoor Mission Development – Diocese of Liverpool	Part-funding two posts to further develop mission and counselling work in an existing community and missional project with high levels of outreach into very deprived neighbourhoods within the Diocese of Liverpool.	£100,000
St Francis, Dalgarno Way – Diocese of London	Development of mission activity in a fast-growing church plant, within the Diocese of London, through employment of a youth worker, targeting children and families in a deprived area with a high proportion of young people.	£100,000
Roving Children’s Missioner for Hackney – Diocese of London	Disseminating a successful model of work with children and young people in 8 parishes, which include areas of very high deprivation in Hackney, London.	£100,000
St Luke’s Church Plant, Millwall – Diocese of London	A collaborative church plant (across church traditions) from a team with a very strong track record in church planting in the Diocese of London.	£100,000

Church in School Development Worker – Diocese of Newcastle	Development, research and replication of a successful Church in Schools programme in very deprived parishes, growing 3 churches and starting 4 more.	£100,000
Newcastle Centre of Mission – Diocese of Newcastle	Development of an existing centre of mission within the Diocese of Newcastle, which has several strands of social outreach and a Fresh Expression of church. The projects funds a trainee and the establishment of a further Fresh Expression.	£100,000
Pioneer Mission Training – Diocese of Sheffield	Funding for pump-priming training and bursaries for pioneer missioners in very deprived parishes.	£100,000
Children and Families Work , The Parish of Radford– Diocese of Southwell & Nottingham	Development of children and families work (including Messy Church) in a very deprived, multi-cultural parish with high population turnover in the Diocese of Southwell and Nottingham.	£100,000
‘People with Learning Disabilities Finding Faith’ (Prospects) – Dioceses of Oxford, Chelmsford and Ripon & Leeds	Establishment of mission centres in 3 dioceses to train clergy and laity in delivering accessible worship for people with learning disabilities.	£50,000
Poole Missional Communities – Diocese of Salisbury	Expansion of a project which has formed small missional communities and simple group-based churches in deprived settings, using lay pioneers under the leadership of a pioneer minister in the Diocese of Salisbury.	£100,000
‘Xtend’ – Diocese of Southwark	Developing and expanding a model which uses missional community groups to grow the church on deprived estates, to grow three new such groups and provide mission apprentice training.	£100,000

Mission and Growth at Wakefield Cathedral – Diocese of Wakefield	Expansion of an existing Cathedral-based Fresh Expression and development of a further Fresh Expression, including training for an intern.	£100,000
Weston Lighthouse Project, Southampton – Diocese of Winchester	Expansion of a community-based evangelism in a largely unchurched, deprived estate in the Diocese of Winchester, through employment of an additional evangelist and a trainee.	£100,000
Tolladine Mission – St Barnabas, Worcester – Diocese of Worcester	Scaling up a successful existing project in the Diocese of Worcester based around a mission community in an area with pockets of exceptional multiple deprivation, by employing a full-time mission leader.	£100,000
'This is not a Project' – Deanery of Hull, Diocese of York	Training and developing 5 mission apprentices, in the Diocese of York, recruited from existing mission and community organisations, in very deprived areas which have exceptionally low levels of church attendance.	£100,000
